What is Title 1?

Federally funded program

 Purpose is to ensure that all students have a fair, equal and significant opportunity to obtain high quality instruction

Provides funds to schools to help support instructional programming

Schoolwide vs Targeted Assistance

Schoolwide Program

- All students identified are eligible for services
- Schools economically disadvantaged rate is 40% or above

Targeted Assistance Program

- Students identified as most at risk are eligible for services
- Schools economically disadvantaged rate is below 40%

Both Programs

- Programs and strategies used are evidenced-based
- Supplemental services provided in addition to regular academic programs
- Progress monitored bi- weekly to evaluate effectiveness

How do students receive Title 1 support?

- All students are screened in the fall using a variety of assessment tools
- Assessment data is analyzed to identify students that are most at-risk
- Students are provided 30-40 minutes of supplemental reading instruction in addition to general academic programming
- Students convene in small groups with a Title teacher that provides evidence-based reading intervention 3 to 5 times per week

Evidence-based programs provided in Title I

Heggerty Phonemic Awareness

Daily, focused lessons on phonemic and phonological awareness

Fundations

A multi-sensory, structured language program that explicitly and systematically teaches reading foundational skills emphasizing:
Phonemic Awareness • Phonics/Word study • High frequency word study • Vocabulary • Handwriting • Spelling • Fluency

Leveled Literacy Intervention

o Intensive, small-group, supplementary literacy intervention for students who find reading and writing difficult.

How do I know if my child is making progress in Title 1?

How do I know if my child is exiting Title I services?

 Progress data is reviewed regularly throughout the year to track growth. If your child makes significant growth in their reading skills, they may be exited from the program. Parents will be notified of this change by your child's Title I teacher.

How can I support my child at home?

- Reading together often
- Ask them questions to determine that they understand what has been read
- Volunteer at your child's school
- Talk with your child about their school day
- Support your child academically when they are assigned homework or other at-home activities
