HONORS COURSES

Students who qualify and choose to schedule for honors courses need to understand the expectations. Although general and honors courses use the same curricular content, honors level classes typically move at a faster pace, demand more rigor, carry a heavier work load, involve more out-of-school study, and require students to think and work more independently. Even if a student qualifies for honors courses, it is strongly advised that parents and students consult the respective teacher(s) in the subject area(s).

Optional: Honors courses are optional and are not necessarily guaranteed to all who qualify.

Qualifying: Students who are requesting to advance from regular/general courses to honors courses are required to earn all A's or two As and one B during the first three marking periods in the requested subject area(s).

Returning Honors Student: Students who are currently enrolled in 7th grade honors courses must maintain grades no lower than all Bs in the respective subject area(s) to advance to 7th grade honors courses in the same subject area.

Foreign Language: Only students who have earned a B average (80%) or greater in Language Arts for the first three marking periods are eligible to take a foreign language.

Honors Algebra 1: To enroll in Honors Algebra, seventh graders will need to have taken Honors Mathematics-7 and must have all As or two As and one B during the first three marking periods. This is a prerequisite for Honors Geometry.

Physical Science Honors: For students to be considered for this course, they must first qualify grade-wise with As and Bs for the first three marking periods in Honors Science-7 and Honors Mathematics-7. Thereafter, they will have a record review of district-wide (MAP scores) and state-wide (Ohio State Tests) data to determine whether they qualify for placement.

Transfer Students: Students transferring to AMS, who have the grades to qualify for honors courses, will need to be assessed and reviewed for such classes.

Schedule Changes: No schedule changes will occur after June 13, 2022 unless there is (1) a technical error in the scheduling process, (2) summer school attendance, (3) a scheduling conflict, or (4) a course failure from the previous year.
