Social Studies - 7th Grade

Course Overview:

The seventh grade World Studies Curriculum covers a timeframe of 750 BCE to 1600 CE. Over the course of year, students will learn four major units. These units roughly correspond with each quarter. The first quarter of seventh grade will be dedicated to studies of Ancient Greece. In the second quarter, students will study the history Ancient Rome. The third quarter is comprised of studies of the Middle Ages, 500 CE to 1500 CE. Finally, the Renaissance will be taught throughout the course of the fourth quarter. In each unit, students growth will be measured through the use of a pretest and posttest. Quizzes and portfolios will be included to conduct formative assessments. Each unit will also have a project to help facilitate student learning and growth.
