Designed as the first social studies of the series, this course will provide each student with an opportunity to enhance his / her essential skills. This course will touch upon the studies of geography, history, economics, civics, and current events. Modern World History serves as a survey of western civilization from the Age of Enlightenment through the Cold War and modern conflicts. Its emphasis will be a world history perspective and serves as the foundation for the American History course. This course meets NCAA eligibility requirements

This course will also introduce skills, concepts, and assessment methods to prepare students for successful completion of AP United States History. Students are expected to complete weekly writing samples of historical research or interpretation. Home internet access is extremely encouraged. This course meets NCAA eligibility requirements.
